Re: Peace to Kelly Lake Capacitors Project

Following up our last letter dated December 13, 2019 on the cancellation of the Peace to Kelly Lake Capacitors Project (PKCP), we are proceeding with the maintenance work previously included as a separate project. The project is in planning phases and construction is anticipated to start at the earliest Spring 2022 with a target in-service date of Fall 2024, subject to regulatory approval.

Peace to Kelly Lake Stations Renewal Project

The new project will address the aging equipment at Peace Canyon and Williston Substations and Kennedy and McLeese Capacitor Stations. The project will replace the equipment that stabilizes power voltage in the two substations and will replace the control system in the two capacitor stations. Additionally, at Kennedy capacitor station and at Williston substation, the existing control buildings will also be replaced.

As noted in the attached project map, at Williston Substation in Prince George, the equipment replacement will require a minor fence expansion onto existing BC Hydro property. The new control building will be adjacent to the existing office and administrations building facing Cummings Road. Below is an artistic rendering of how it may look from Cummings Road.
